## **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. <u>Participation & Entry Fee:</u> Each exhibitor must provide \$5/animal (non-refundable) early entry or \$10/animal (late or day of show) entry to be eligible to participate. All early entries are due **April 26, 2019** to the Powhatan Farm Bureau office.
- 2. **No Drugs Allowed:** The use of behavior altering drugs will be prohibited on the show grounds. All violators will be disqualified from the show as viewed by the Protest Committee of the show.
- 3. <u>Weigh-In:</u> All registered exhibitors must be present at weigh-in and show their own animals, unless excused or medical or family emergency only. If exhibitor is excused, animal must be shown by another exhibitor registered in same species. Species classes may be subject to change, at the discretion of the show committee, due to size or composition of the class.
- 4. <u>Champions:</u> All animals must be shown in class and available to be placed in show ring, by their owner, to be eligible for Champion or Reserve Champion of the show.
- 5. All animals must be the property of or leased by the 4-H or FFA member and must be cared for by the member making the exhibit.
- 6. **Showing 2 or more animals:** If an exhibitor has two or more animals in a single class, the additional animal(s) may only be shown by another exhibitor registered to participate in that species show. Violation of this rule may result in the exhibitor's and/or animals' disqualification.
- 7. <u>Fitting:</u> Fitting consists of clipping and grooming your show animal. No paid professional fitters are allowed.
- **8.** <u>Quality Assurance Guidelines:</u> It is recommended you follow species specific Quality Assurance guidelines for vaccination. Contact your local extension agent if assistance or additional information is needed.
- 9. Males: All male market animals must have no testicular tissue and be healed from castration.
- **10.** <u>Rejection:</u> The owner/operator of the show has the authority to reject any animal due to health or any other reason.
- 11. <u>Showmanship Heats:</u> Showmanship classes exceeding 6 exhibitors will be divided into showmanship heats. Participants for each heat will be selected via a lottery system. The championship drive for such divided showmanship classes will be comprised of all exhibitors selected from the heats by the judge. The judge shall select at least one exhibitor from each heat and has the discretion to select as many additional exhibitors from each heat as he or she deems eligible for the championship drive. Should a showmanship class only have one exhibitor, that exhibitor may elect to move to a different age class.
- 12. <u>Pictures and Media:</u> Each exhibitor must have picture taken with each species of animal shown. Pictures of exhibitors may be taken during the show and sale and may be used for promotional purposes.
- **13.** <u>4-H Code of Conduct:</u> Everyone present at the show will be expected to adhere to the established 4-H Rules of Conduct.
- 14. Pets: NO PETS ALLOWED
- **15.** <u>Showing off trailer / Pens:</u> There will be pen space available but showing off trailers is also encouraged. Please specify if you will need pen space in registration.
- **16. Premiums:** To be paid day of show.

15. Heart of Virginia Showmanship Championship: Youth participating in the Piedmont Jr. Livestock Show in Blackstone the same year are eligible for the Championship by showing at the Heart of Virginia Youth Livestock Show at the Powhatan Celebration of the Horse & AG EXPO. The Championship will be based on showmanship with points given for each placing and totaled between the two shows. A champion and reserve champion will be awarded for each age group (senior, intermediate, junior and novice) and each species (beef, sheep, goat) if there are eligible exhibitors participating in both shows.

## **AGE POLICY**

Showmanship classes for all species will be established using the following age groups:

#### Virginia 4-H Membership Age Policy

Junior 9 - 12 year olds Intermediate 13 - 15 year olds Senior 16 - 19 year olds

\*Novice \*9 - 12 year olds\* \*first time showing\*

Eligibility for 4-H membership terminates on December 31 of the year the member has their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday. For each of the above categories, youth must turn the entry age during the 4-H year October 1 - September 30. For example:

- Junior category: Youth who turn 9 between October 1, 2018 and September 30, 2019
- Intermediate category: Youth who turn 13 between October 1, 2018 and September 30, 2019
- Senior category: Youth who turn 16 between October 1, 2018 and September 30, 2019

### **BEEF**

- 1. A maximum of two cattle may be shown per non-showmanship class per exhibitor. If more than one animal owned by same exhibitor is in a class, please read General Rules.
- 2. All animals must be dehorned.
- 3. Dairy feeder steers include dairy breeds and dairy cross breeds. Dairy feeder steer minimum weight is 300 lbs and 400 lbs for beef feeder steers. All feeder steers must be born before January 1 of current year.
- 4. Steers classes will be split by weight and number of entries. All steers must be under a year and 7months (19months) of age.
- 5. Heifers classes will be split by age and number of entries.
- 6. Purebred and crossbred heifers will show in the same age class.
- 7. All beef classes, animals may be unfitted but must be clean and dry.
- 8. Cows will show with the most recent natural-born calf at side. Calves must be born prior to April 1 of the current show year. Calves must be shown on halter.
- 9. The intention of the Cow/Calf class is to allow exhibitors to bring back their heifer calves as wet 2 year olds and show them with their calves at side. This highlights the fact that Virginia is primarily a cow/calf state and illustrates the completion of the exhibitor's heifers entering the cow herd as mama cows.

## **DAIRY HEIFER & COW**

- 1. A maximum of two cattle may be shown per non-showmanship class per exhibitor. If more than one animal owned by same exhibitor is in a class, please read General Rules.
- 2. Heifers and cows will be split by age and number of entries.
- 3. All cattle classes, animals may be unfitted but must be clean and dry.
- 4. Classes:
  - 10 Senior Showmanship
  - 11 Intermediate Showmanship
  - 12 Junior Showmanship
  - 13 Novice Showmanship
  - 14 Dairy Heifer Class
  - 15 Dairy Cow

## **SHEEP**

- 1. Each exhibitor may show up to two lambs and two ewes.
- 2. All lambs must be docked (according to breed standards).
- 3. All lambs must be shorn before the day of the show. Trimming may be done after weigh-in.
- 4. All lambs must weigh 80 pounds minimum, must have their lamb teeth and be less than one year old.
- 5. Ewes must be shown in market or ewe class, not both.
- 6. Ewe classes will be split by weight and number of entries.
- 7. Classes:
  - 16 Senior Showmanship
  - 17 Intermediate Showmanship
  - 18 Junior Showmanship
  - 19 Novice Showmanship
  - 20 Market Lamb
  - 21 Commercial Ewe Lamb

### **MEAT GOAT**

- 1. Each exhibitor may show a maximum of two market goats and two does.
- 2. Market Goats can be wethers or does, but does shown in the market goat class are not eligible to show in the commercial doe class.
- 3. All goats must be dehorned or have the tips blunted.
- 4. Goats must weigh between 45—115 pounds, and be less than one year old.
- 5. Doe classes will be determined by weight and not by breed. Purebred and crossbred will show in the same weight class.
